

ENDOWMENT FUND

Did you know......Did you know the church has an Endowment Fund? It was established in 1987 and offers you a way to make a gift that will continue to grow and benefit the church year after year.

The principal of your gift remains untouched in the Endowment Fund. The income that is generated by that principal can be used to promote and develop religious, charitable and educational activities. It can also be used for non-recurring purposes *not* regularly budgeted. Recent examples of how income from this fund was used includes \$1,000 for the sign fund, \$1,000 for the Food distribution program and \$8,000 for the roof fund.

Please note that a gift to the Endowment Fund *should not* take the place of your pledge. Your annual pledge is the lifeblood of the church's financial health. The Endowment Fund is a separate part of the church's mission. It is designed to supplement our primary church activities and provide special assistance on as "as needed" basis.

Contributions to the Endowment Fund can be made in several ways: cash or check, securities, bequests (leaving something by will) and memorials. If you would like more information or are interested in making a contribution, please contact the church office.


